 - all retreats and special events unless specified

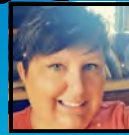
..if students are found using their cell phone when it is prohibited, a leader has the right to confiscate the phone until the event is over..

9. unwholesome talk such as swearing, perverse or discriminatory language, and put-downs are prohibited.

During the summer, SWAT enjoys the longer days and warm weather by spending time outdoors in fellowship with one another.

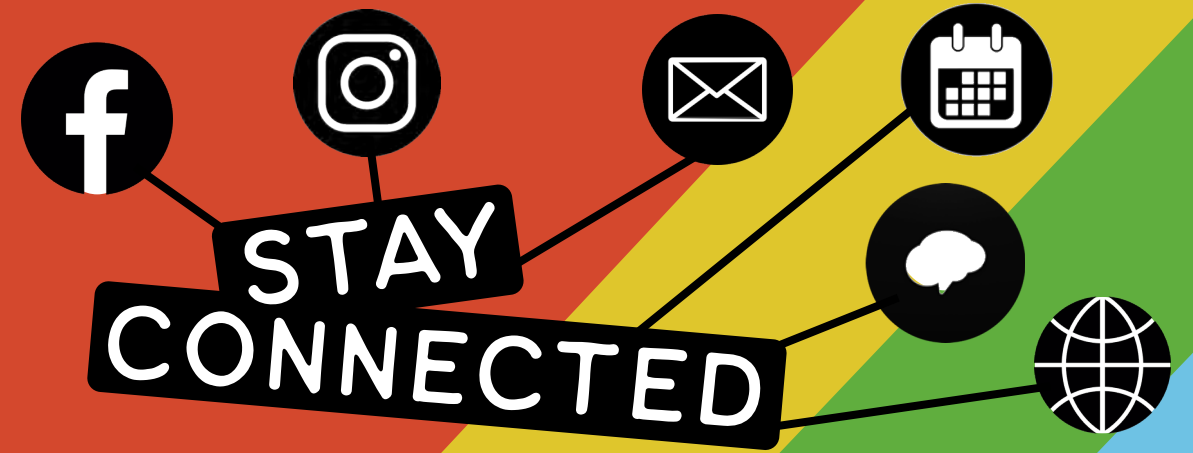
From 7-8 pm we usually can be found playing ultimate Frisbee on the CBC soccer field, but there are tons of other things to do as well.

Prayer/Care/ Share Nights

Weekly Dare

On our last mission trip, we were given a dare each day to intentionally advance the gospel in our community. We want to do the same on Wednesday nights! Each week, a high school student will challenge our youth group to a weekly dare.

Dares might include:

- *Call a friend and share what you learned at SWAT.
- *Invite a friend to church.
- *Share the gospel with a friend this week.
- *Gift a bible to a friend.

We meet during the middle hour from 9:45 to 10:45 AM. During this time, we study God's word through guided discussions and interactive
