SMALL GROUP QUESTIONS

• Read Matthew 3 and discuss the difference between the baptism of John and the baptism we read about in Acts 2 this week.

- Pastor Keith referenced the trinitarian nature of baptism—that each member of the Godhead is present and participating (cf. Matthew 28:19). Why is that important? How does that change your understanding of baptism?
- How does church membership relate to baptism and why are both of these important steps to take as a follower of Jesus Christ? Encourage one another to make these important steps if you have not already.

• Read Romans 6:1-4. What are the implications of these verses? Why is baptism more than just a declaration or signification of our changed hearts by his Spirit?

- Have you ever been baptized? Why is this an important step to take in your Christian life?
- Discuss why people become church members. What does that mean and why is this important as well?
- When you witnessed the baptisms today in church, what was your reaction? How did what you heard about baptism change your thinking and/or calm your worries about being baptized?
