PRAYER FROM THE HEART 1—MATTHEW 6:9-10

## **SMALL GROUP QUESTIONS**

You've most likely heard this prayer (part of Scripture) dozens of times.
What stood out to you this time around as Keith introduced this familiar text?



- Jesus makes a big deal about the Father "in heaven" in this sermon (see 5:12, 16, 48; 6:1, 9). Why is he making the distinction, and how does that inform Jesus' first words in this prayer?
- Why is God's name and his name's holiness of prime importance in this prayer? Why is that the first thing we should pray for/about when we pray?
- If, upon Jesus' return (second advent) the heavens and earth will pass away and he'll recreate all things new, why do we insist upon God's kingdom and will being done on earth now (v. 10)?
- **SERMON QUESTION:** What does authentic kingdom prayer look like?

## **FAMILY QUESTIONS**

- What does "hallowed" mean, and why do we want God's "name" to be "hallowed" (v. 9)?
- Why does Jesus keep referring to our Father "in heaven" (see verses above)?
  Why is it important that our Father is "in heaven"?

 What does it mean for God's kingdom to come on earth (v. 10)? Why is that important to pray for?
